WHITE

Sweetness rating 1 (dry) to 5 (sweet)

South Africa

A young and snappy South African Chenin. Delicious green apple aromas interlace with passion fruit to create this brilliantly refreshing wine. Rating; 2 ABV 13%

Italy

Fresh, dry and delicate with gentle floral and citrus aromas. A classic Italian white wine. Rating; 1 ABV 12%

Chile

A blend of herbal notes and fresh tropical fruit such as grapefruit, pineapple, and mango. It is fresh in style with balanced acidity that enhances the fruity palate. Rating; 1 ABV 12%

France

Peach, pear and tropical notes are all prominent on the very generous nose. The palate is rich, yet fresh with hints of citrus and lychee

USA

Initial scents of pineapple and mango give way to aromas of pear and vanilla. A rich mouthfeel shows flavours of bananas, baked apples and toffee. A touch of acidity balances a note of sweet butter on the crisp finish. Rating; 2 ABV 14.5%

France

Floral and fruity bouquet with crisp, citrus fruit, great length, and piercing tones of limestone minerality. Round, lush and utterly elegant. Rating; 3 ABV 12.5%

RED

Weight rating A (lightest) to 5 (heaviest)

France

The palate is soft and round with hints of blackcurrants, good structure and approachable tannins. A full-flavoured, easy-drinking classic of the Languedoc. Rating; A ABV 12.5%

Spain

Dark cherry, blackcurrant and forest fruit flavours combine with earthy notes of sweet spice, offering a delicious and smooth glass of red. Rating; A ABV 13%

South Africa

Prunes, cherries and ripe berry notes with hints of vanilla oak. The palate is filled with ripe fruit and smooth tannins with a long aftertaste.
