Bird Island – Chenin Blanc

South Africa

A young and snappy South African Chenin. Delicious green apple aromas interlace with passion fruit to create this brilliantly refreshing wine. Rating; 2 ABV 13%

Laroma – Pinot Grigio

Italy

Fresh, dry and delicate with gentle floral and citrus aromas. A classic Italian white wine. Rating; 1 ABV 12%

Chile

Spain

Dark cherry, blackcurrant and forest fruit flavours combine with earthy notes of sweet spice, offering a delicious and smooth glass of red. Rating; A ABV 13%

USA

Initial scents of pineapple and mango give way to aromas of pear and vanilla. A rich mouthfeel shows flavours of bananas, baked apples and toffee. A touch of acidity balances a note of sweet butter on the crisp finish. Rating; 2 ABV 14.5%

Sauvignon Blanc

France

Floral and fruity bouquet with crisp, citrus fruit, great length, and piercing tones of limestone minerality. Round, lush and utterly elegant. Rating; 3 ABV 12.5%

Argentina

Attractive notes of sweet black cherry and a silky-smooth mouthfeel. Not a heavy Malbec but one designed to be versatile with food yet easy enough to drink on its own. Rating; C ABV 13.5%
