Our Commitments

Sourcing

- Adhere to the University's <u>Sustainable Food Policy</u>, aligning catering with responsible sourcing practices.
- Use reusable, recyclable, or compostable materials for event décor, signage, and equipment.
- Prioritise digital and reusable promotional materials; avoid single-use products.
- Work predominantly with local suppliers to support the regional economy.
- Provide environmentally friendly toiletries with measured carbon reductions in guest bedrooms

Environment

- Encourage public transport, walking, or cycling to events by providing clear information and incentives.
- Promote car-sharing and the use of on-campus electric vehicle charging stations.
- Offer clients hybrid and virtual attendance options where possible.
- Encourage accommodation guests to reuse towels to reduce laundryrelated environmental impacts.

Society

 Monitor, review, and communicate sustainable practices across all Event Exeter services.













- Engage with the local community by sourcing from ethical suppliers, promoting local culture and biodiversity, and supporting environmental initiatives.
- Promote preferential Great Western Rail train rates for Event Exeter delegates.
- Ensure events are accessible and inclusive, promoting equality, diversity, and inclusion.
- Offer preferential rates to non-profit organisations.
- Showcase seasonal produce in menu development and hospitality delivery.
- Share sustainability initiatives with clients, suppliers, and attendees before, during, and after events via digital channels.
- Provide sustainability continual professional development training, coaching and resources for Event Exeter staff.

Monitoring and Reporting

- Where possible, measure the environmental impact of events using tools for tracking energy, waste, and carbon output.
- Gather feedback from attendees, clients, and partners on sustainability and use this data for continuous improvement.
- Regularly review and update this policy to reflect best practices and align with broader University goals.
